

Reflections on what the world is going through now.

I observe the international events around us to see their impact on the world in light of the critical circumstances the world is going through now. I start with the Russian-Ukrainian war. After the fall of the Soviet Union, America, and NATO began to tighten the noose on Russia by placing nuclear missiles on the countries bordering Russia. Putin has tried to persuade America and NATO to remove the missiles because they threaten Russia's security but to no avail.

Putin also noticed that Ukraine has become a thorn in Russia's back because it has become a hotbed of intrigue and conspiracies against Russia, as Putin complained that America has filled it with factories producing deadly germs directed against Russia. Putin wanted also to fight the neo-Nazi organizations which penetrated the Ukrainian government and most of the major military positions.

Crimea, which Putin seized from Ukraine in 2014, is of strategic significance to Russia. One reason why Crimea is so important to Russia is that it hosts the natural harbor of Sevastopol the only deep-water port of Russia's Black Sea littoral. Without Sevastopol, Russia would not have a home for its Black Sea fleet which it uses to project power into the Mediterranean.

Anti-Russian forces in Ukraine, including the leaders of the pro-Western "Orange Revolution" (2004), have repeatedly raised the issue of ending the Russian fleet's stay on the peninsula. But the agreement, signed by the two heads of state in the Ukrainian city of Kharkiv in 2010, extended the duration of the Russian fleet until 2042, in exchange for Russia paying \$100 million a year in fare to its naval bases in Sevastopol.

The recent Ukrainian coup that brought Zelensky to power in Kyiv and forces that do not hide their hostility to Russia came to threaten once again the survival of the Russian fleet on the peninsula, which raised legitimate concern in Moscow and was one of the most prominent motives for its support for the Crimean people's movement against the

coup and their expression of their will to join Russia, as well as the motive of protecting Russians from attacks by ultra-nationalists. Accepting Crimea's accession to Russia has undoubtedly allowed it to remove the threat to its military presence in a region of great strategic importance to Russia.

To Putin's anger, Zelensky approved Ukraine's new national security strategy, which provides for the development of a privileged partnership with NATO to obtain membership within the alliance. Zelensky also signed a strategy to end the occupation, reintegrate, and recover the occupied territories of the Republic of Crimea. This was the main reason for Putin to start his military campaign in Ukraine.

Biden became furious and began to approach the situation out of anger and revenge not from the logic of reason. He didn't consider the strength of his enemy. He thought Putin was weak and could be easily eliminated as America did with the countries of the former Soviet Union through a proxy war. He thought that a proxy war against Russia, the confiscation of her assets abroad (400 billion dollars), and preventing her from exporting gas to Europe would deplete her resources and would make the Russians revolt against their leader and remove him from power.

This severe sanction, however, was the rope with which Biden hanged himself. Depriving Russia of its assets made many countries condemn this act because it is not reasonable for countries to build their wealth and then be stolen by another country because her currency is the main currency used in all global transactions! This oppressive and tyrannical piracy was rejected by many countries, and they began to think about an alternative currency other than the dollar.

When Western countries refrained from importing gas from Russia under the influence of Biden, and when they blew up Nord 1 and Nord 2 gas lines, Putin decided to permanently ban gas from NATO countries. Their factories stopped accordingly, and they suffered stagnation and inflation. Revolutions spread in their countries denouncing the bitter reality in which they live.

America and NATO came together to put a low ceiling on the price of Russian oil, but it did not work because Putin sold his gas to China and India in local currencies such as rubles, rupees, and Chinese yuan. He also sold it to Asian countries in their local currencies. He further

exported his oil and gas via boats that were not subject to Western insurance companies and agreed with Saudi Arabia through OPEC + to reduce the production of gas and oil to increase its market price and constitute a burden on America and the NATO countries. Putin thus improved his economy, and the price of the ruble rose against the dollar from what it was before the war with Ukraine.

NATO countries revolted against Biden, as acting on his advice to prevent gas imports from Russia had devastated their economy, so he promised them that he would find a solution that would solve all their problems. The solution was that he would order his obedient servants, namely the Gulf countries, to increase the pumping of more oil into the global market until prices begin to fall, and the pressure on the NATO governments from their people stops, especially with the approach of midterm elections for Congress.

Biden believed that once he asked the Gulf countries to increase oil production, the response would be immediate, but what happened was just the opposite. Biden has forgotten that he spoke very badly about Mohammed bin Salman, and vowed in his campaign to make Saudi Arabia and its leaders' pariah as punishment for the murder of columnist Jamal Khashoggi. Biden tried to speak by phone with Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman and Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed but they declined his call.

Biden forgot that when he took office he withdrew his troops from the Middle East and let the Houthis strike oil refineries in Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates. Leaving the Gulf unprotected, America's prestige in the Gulf weakened and the interest of the gulf estates shifted from America to unbiased and more responsive countries such as Russia and China.

Biden found that he had the opportunity to supply NATO countries with American gas, which he sold to them at three times the price of Russian gas, taking advantage of their urgent need for gas. This has provoked the anger of NATO countries, and they began to criticize him strongly, especially Macron, who stated that NATO countries should not take orders from abroad and should be independent of America in their decisions. Macron has not forgotten the deception of America and England when they nullified the French submarine deal with Australia to unilaterally supply Australia with nuclear submarines. Thus, the first signs of disintegration in NATO began to appear.

Biden depleted the resources of NATO countries when he forced them to supply Ukraine with waves of weapons until their stores were empty of them. NATO then entered the trap of economic stagnation and the people revolted against their governments.

Biden also drained U.S. resources. Although America was already indebted to the world with 31 trillion dollars, Biden gave Ukraine the largest military aid worth more than \$46 billion. Anger and revenge against Putin were what moved him, not the voice of reason.

The US presidential elections approached, and Biden announced that he would run for a second term, but he found himself a losing card in front of the American voters, as NATO countries rejected him for draining their resources and failing to provide them with gas. Also, the Gulf States refused to cooperate with him and followed the policies of pumping gas through OPEC + according to their interests and away from American hegemony.

One of Biden's biggest mistakes is his lack of knowledge of the Arab feelings toward the Israelis and the United Kingdom. The Arabs until this moment cursed Arthur Balfour, the British Minister of Foreign Affairs in 1927 and his shameful and humiliating declaration, which robbed their land, and gave it to the Israelis at the expense of the Palestinians, the original owners of the land.

Ever since the Palestinians lived with the Israelis in the occupied territory, they have been tormented, maltreated, and humiliated by the Israelis. The Palestinians and the Arabs do not forget the massacres committed by the Israelis against the Palestinians, such as that of the town of Sheikh in 1947, the massacre of Deir Yassin in 1948, the massacre of the village of Abu Shusha in 1946, the massacre of Tantura in 1948, the massacre of Qibya in 1953, the massacre of Qalqilya in 1956, the massacre of Kafr Qassim in 1956, the massacre of Khan Yunus in 1956, the massacre of Tel al-Zaatar in 1976, the massacre of Sabra and Shatila in 1982, the Al-Aqsa Mosque massacre in 1990, the Haram AL Ebrahimi massacre in 1994, Jenin Camp in 2002, and the current brutal massacre in Gaza Strip in 2023. The Israelis desecrated the mosques, prevented the Palestinians from praying in the Al-Aqsa Mosque, and prevented Christians from praying in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. These massacres and torture were carried out with the intention of ethnic cleansing of Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza Strip to empty Palestine of its people and force them to leave their

homelands. The West, especially America, has confronted these atrocities either with complete silence or by declaring the stupid statement that the Israelis have the right to defend themselves and to hell with the Palestinians!

The Arabs began to evaluate their relationship with America. What do they gain from America other than exploitation and destruction? They agreed to sell their oil in dollars, and this increased the value of the dollar worldwide, but what was the return? The American weapons they buy with billions every year are intentionally less effective than those Israel takes for free. The Arabs are upset with the American double standards.

Before the Iraqi war started, the Arabs saw how the American land was prepared to spread hatred against Muslims. The American administration had to invent an excuse, even if it was false, to justify the war on Iraq. The Muslims saw how the Islamophobia industry was vigorously sponsored and established by American Zionists. They saw how Muslims were falsely pictured as terrorists, bloodthirsty and infidels who do not follow the true religion, and that the Koran is a theft from the Bible. They saw their religion defamed, insulted, and attacked by the Christian leaders and congressmen from both parties. They saw their Koran burned, their prophet insulted, and called the worst epithets. Iraq was then destroyed followed by Yemen, Syria, and Libya. The purpose was to steal the Middle East's resources by fragmenting its countries and splitting its people into sects and factions living scattered without borders. Egypt was also on the verge of collapse, but with God's help she was able to stand firm and not fall. The Islamic militias were sponsored by America to cause unrest and destroy the Arab world.

Since the idea of destroying the Arab world for the benefit of Israel was originally an Israeli idea, which appeared and first published in 1980, the United States was the Israeli tool to carry out this vile plan starting from Clinton to Bush the son to Obama and now Biden.

Biden should have understood the exact situation in occupied Palestine. Honest words describing the brutal and humiliating treatment of the Palestinians at the hands of the Israelis over 74 years are those expressed by Noam Chomsky who said: "Take my water, burn my olive trees, destroy my house, steal my land, imprison my father, kill my mother, bombard my country, starve us all, humiliate us all but I am to blame. I shot a rocket back."

When Biden came to the Middle East after the Gaza massacre, the Arabs thought he would care about their calamity, but he sided completely with Israel and brought with him aircraft carriers and battleships to discipline the already slaughtered people of Gaza. American foreign policy is built on what the Zionists and AIPAC decide, not on what the American people wish. Biden declared when he visited Israel that he was more Zionist than the Zionists themselves and that if Israel did not exist, America would have invented it. So, the president of the United States is subservient to international Zionism, and to protect his presidency, he doesn't mind sacrificing America's important relationship with the Arabs.

Biden should have known that what Hamas did was the result of torture and massacres committed against the Palestinians over 74 years. The Palestinians were put in tents and locked camps after the Israelis demolished their homes and stole their land to build Jewish settlements on it. The Israelis treated the Palestinians like animals, they killed them, imprisoned them, and expelled them from their country under false pretexts.

Biden should have known that what happened from Hamas was a reaction that accumulated over years of oppression and not an act of hostility as portrayed by the Israelis. Hamas was defending Gaza against the Israeli atrocity.

Biden should have known that Hamas is the military wing of the Palestinians and not a terrorist organization. Hamas is a military organization formed as a result of the unjust and humiliating treatment of the Israelis against the Palestinians. In other words, Hamas is the military wing of the Palestinians.

Biden, after he failed in Ukraine and Europe, gave the green light to Israel to take revenge on Gaza by demolishing it as if the logic of terror would solve the problem. In the Security Council, Biden refused to vote in favor of the ceasefire resolution in Gaza. Hence the massacre continued without mercy. Women, children, men, the elderly, and the sick were killed by thousands. Buildings and hospitals were demolished. The survivors were crammed into a narrow valley to bring them to the Egyptian border for resettlement in Sinai and then bombed and killed. The plan was to destroy Gaza by bombing civilians with airplanes and displacing them from northern Gaza to its south towards the Egyptian border and settling them in Sinai, which is Egyptian territory. But Egypt

is not a weak country that obeys what America or Israel say. El-Sisi has made Egypt a strong nation that the aggressors feared. Egypt is the largest Arab country in the region and has the most powerful army. Egypt refused to displace the people of Gaza in the Sinai territories because that would liquidate the Palestinian cause and would be stealing the land of Egypt and giving it away to solve Israel's problems at Egypt's expense. As it seemed, the plan was to fragment the Middle East again, but this time by taking away part of Sinai to settle the people of Gaza who were displaced because of the tyranny of the Israelis. But El-Sisi stood firm and announced at the peace conference within earshot of Israel and America and the world at large, that there is no settlement in Sinai, and that the resettlement of Gazans in Sinai means the liquidation of the Palestinian cause and that this conflict if not solved peacefully will take the region to a long war with no end.

America reviewed its position, if Egypt enters the war, Israel is over. Israel has been defeated by Hamas and the resistance rockets are still raining down on it from all sides. America's warships at sea are exposed to Egyptian submarines, frigates equipped with naval and air missiles, fast missile boats, Rafale, MiG-29, and Mirage warplanes, naval thunderbolt teams, coastal naval missile launchers, submarines, and a huge army of 1.2 million soldiers equipped with the latest and most lethal weapons. Sisi's military doctrine is either to live with dignity or die with honor on the battlefield. Egypt believes that the solution to the Palestinian-Israeli problem is to establish a permanent homeland for the Palestinians with East Jerusalem as its capital. A homeland that includes Gaza and the West Bank. It enjoys complete independence from Israel. Its state is recognized by all countries of the world and is represented in the United Nations.

US military leaders informed Biden that there is no budget for the maintenance of half of the US fleet, especially submarines, that American bases in the Middle East are now hit with missiles and drones, and that if the bombing of Gaza does not stop, Hezbollah will enter the war as well as Iran and its militia in Syria and Iraq and that America will not be able to pursue or repel all this. Moreover, China has sent 6 ships from its fleet equipped with hypersonic missiles that do not miss the target, and Russia has sent her planes equipped with the terrifying Kinzhal missiles over the Black Sea thus exposing the American fleet. Biden reviewed his position and ordered Netanyahu to

stop the invasion of Gaza until he found an outlet to save the face of Israel.

America is a partner and supporter of Israel in this aggression. It gave Israel all political cover and military supplies and adopted false and misleading Israeli propaganda when it said that the occupation army did not target civilians.

More than 70% of the martyrs were women, children, and the elderly, and all of them were civilians. If these were not civilians, then who are the civilians according to American belief? Biden agreed that Netanyahu continues destroying Gaza but does not harm civilians. What hypocrisy and blatant lies to people. Biden continues to unconditionally back the destruction of Gaza and the killing of thousands of Palestinians including thousands of children even if the vast majority of the American public wants to cease fire. America is the only one that opposed the Arab project presented to the Security Council, considering Gaza to be a region that threatens world peace. None of America's Western allies supported America in her unfair decision against the Palestinians. They rejected America's humiliating submission to Israel's decision of continuing to kill unarmed civilians. This is a glaring evidence of America's involvement in this criminal war.

It's because of Biden's reckless policies that the world is now moving towards a new multi-world order and the exchange of the dollar for other currencies. The beginning of the disintegration of NATO as a result of Biden's poor decisions in managing the alliance against Russia, the defeat of NATO and America in Ukraine, and the fire raging in the Middle East due to Biden's blindsiding with Israel, clearly demonstrate Biden's failure as a politician.

Biden's foreign policy is not based on reason and rationality but on revenge and defiance. Putin wanted to take certain areas in eastern Ukraine and stop expanding. And here Biden could have sat and talked with Putin, but Biden stubbornly thought he could defeat Putin by supporting Ukraine with money and weapons, and by using Zelensky as a toy that he moves as he pleases. Thus, he prolonged the war in Ukraine until Putin swallowed up the entire country, not just the east, but stood now on the borders of Finland, and Poland. He even placed his nuclear missiles in Belarus, threatening the whole of Europe.

Biden thought he could plunge Putin into the quagmire of Ukraine and forgot that Russia is a powerful nuclear power as well and that Putin does not hesitate to use nuclear weapons if he feels seriously threatened. Biden forgot that China and North Korea stood in Putin's back supporting him. He forgot that Putin was fighting severely to establish a multi-polar world free from American hegemony and that his success in this war was a guarantee for the establishment of the new world order. In other words, Biden, with his failed policies in the East and West, has hastened the existence of a new world order in which America does not play the role of the sole pole. America and NATO must reconcile with Russia instead of being hostile. Talks and concessions should have begun months ago to reach a formula that satisfies both parties. But America's delay in this matter and its false perception that she would win the battle made Russia swallow up all of Ukraine.

Russia wanted to stop in the east, but Biden's stubbornness encouraged Zelensky to continue a losing war, that displaced and killed millions of Ukrainian people.

Now NATO turned against America and rejected her lame policy in Europe. Some NATO countries demanded independence from American dominance and the adoption of independent policies of their own. Rather, some NATO countries sympathized with Russia and started dealing with it commercially.

If we look at Taiwan, this issue could also have been solved diplomatically by rational negotiation, because losing China as a major trade ally with America is a great loss for America and also for China, especially since America has officially admitted that Taiwan is Chinese land. Still, the American vanity in the era of Biden made China challenge America militarily and economically. Biden behaved as if he owned the world and forgot that he owed China and the world \$31 trillion.

Biden's wrong decisions impoverished America and made it poorer. During his reign, he engaged in conflicts in three regions of the world. America lost its allies in the Middle East by blindly siding with Israel and agreeing that Israel bombards and kills the innocents in Gaza. America weakened her relations with her European allies, gained enmity with Russia and China, and put the world on the brink of a nuclear war whose extent and end no one knows.

Senator Mike Johnson, Speaker of the US House of Representatives, submitted a request to Congress to impeach Biden for concealing his son's financial crimes.

Biden endangered the American fleet in the Mediterranean. Force is not a parade of huge warships at sea. Large naval vessels are no longer of much use in the age of missiles. Power is not by its display but by a set of intellectual and cognitive faculties leading to rational attitudes and actions. But where is Biden, from all this?

One more thing to say here. With the electoral elections approaching, Biden could be wise and more rational if he sits with the Russians now and makes a peace settlement, as well as pressuring the Israelis to cease fire and stop pushing the Gazans by force to the Egyptian border to settle in Sinai. Also, to give the Palestinians an independent State with Eastern Jerusalem as its capital.

Biden can win the votes of the American voters by stopping the war on Gaza and preventing the Palestinian exodus to Sinai, thereby preventing a fierce war that will occur between Egypt and Israel in which Iran, Hezbollah, the Houthis in Yemen, and the militias in Syria will participate, and behind them are Russia, China, and North Korea.

This man has put the entire world on the brink of a massive, atomic war.
